

## FLOOR CARE AND MAINTENANCE

- To clean, regularly sweep or vacuum, along with periodic use of an approved no-wax hardwood floor cleaner.
- Clean up spills promptly with a soft cloth and recommended products.
- Place felt-type protectors on the bottom of all furniture and fixture legs to assist in preventing denting and scratching.
- To prevent scratches and dents, avoid wearing spiked shoes (such as sports cleats) on flooring.
- The exposure of sun, UV rays, and artificial lighting can cause the wood and/or stain to change color and/or fade over time.
